

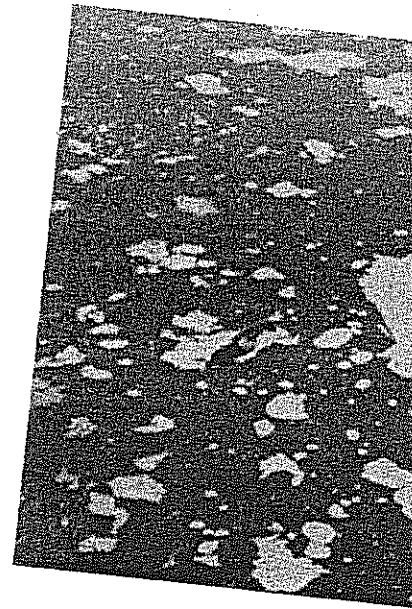
# IMPORTANT INFO PLEASE READ

At this time, beaches can remain open for swimming.  
If a bloom is suspected or observed in a swimming area, bathers should refrain from swimming.  
Avoid areas with surface scums and heavily discolored water.  
Pets should be kept out of the water.

## **BLUE-GREEN ALGAE BLOOM ADVISORY**

**Blue-green algae bloom(s) have been spotted in this waterbody.**



- Don't swim, wade or fish near blooms or surface scum
- Don't drink the water
- Keep children and animals away from any blooms or scums
- Rinse with clean water if exposed
- Consider medical attention if you have symptoms of nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea; skin, eye or throat irritation, allergic reactions or breathing difficulties. Report symptoms to the local health department.
