sure way, that you will know valuable information about the Grove. Not everyone is on Facebook, not everyone reads the flyers – BUT everyone can easily be given information by Robo-call. It is efficient and quick. If you are presently not registered, again, please give the office the best number to get these messages on.

Taking your dogs to the North End to run around and get exercise is wonderful; BUT, as we all know, dogs will poop anywhere. It is starting to be an issue when others take a walk in the North End and step in poop. Let your dog run...its great...but please watch them when they are and pick up their poop before you leave the North End. Complaints are increasing. Vail's Grove Court Committee



This committee is appointed by Vail's Grove Cooperative Board of Directors to prepare and share a development plan for the North End Court Renovation. The current courts are in disrepair. In years past, the courts served as a social and recreational resource to Vail's Grove residents increasing community use of shared cooperative space. New courts would be an amenity that adds value to our community and homes.

To inform this process, a survey has been created to poll Vail's Grove residents regarding their needs, preferences, and ideas for the project. Each household will be allowed one response, which will be tracked by name, street address and email responses. While a survey return rate of ~30% is acceptable, 50% is an excellent return rate, especially when informing financial decisions. The Grove has 172 homes, 52-60 responses are our goal. By now you should have received the survey in printed format. This can be returned to the office at any time before 1/31/2024 to be counted. Completing the survey using the scan code below is the most immediate response.

We urge you to exercise the opportunity for sharing your preferences, ideas and being involved in the decision by weighing in through this survey. Where the responses are not anonymous, your participation and answers will be kept within the committee and used in a general manner. Specific answers will not be matched to the individual's response. If you share an interest in helping, we will be in touch. Buildings and Grounds from Michael Early

Recently we have experienced multiple ground water leaks throughout the Grove. We will continue to investigate these issues as they could undermine roads and cause hazards during the winter. Polye Lane and 91-93 Vail's Lake Shore are two areas that freeze during the winter months. We ask that you are especially careful in these areas when temperatures are below freezing.

VRI investigated the grinder pump alarm at the Pavilion. Potentially, we may need electrical breakers to avoid recurrence. Several potholes in the community have been repaired by Salem Landscaping. What started as a single leak on Hickory Lane turned out to be at least two or more. Butler Excavating needed to cut through rock to create proper trench. New drains have been installed. Future work will continue up the path to Maple Lane where there are rotted drainpipes.

I thank everyone for their patience and assistance over the past few weeks. Just to name a few: Cindy Battreall, Petr Trlica, Juliann Salerno, Ellen Mytych, David Janecek, Brian Fitzgerald, and the Foley family. My apologies to those who I may have missed.


Recreation Report By Peter Vincent
