Also, remember that this Directory is for personal use only – not for mass mailings or commercial or business use.


Some tidbits of info: When you purchase your house here at the Grove, you receive either the original or copy of your Proprietary Lease and Stock Certificate at closing. Please be sure you have a copy available and remember where you keep it. You will need that if and when you sell, refinance, need to know how many shares you own for tax purposes, etc. It is your responsibility to hold on to these papers for your reference. In addition, all sales, rentals, re-finances and many alterations to your home require Board review and approval. Please always check with the office prior to pursuing any of the above so you know what the process is. You can also take a look at the Bylaws/Rules and Regulations, which are on the website, and was also sent to you in book form last year.

Just a little reminder: Quarterly bills go out on Jan. 1, April 1, July 1, and Oct. 1st. Payment for that bill is due IN the office by last day of month. I do statements and assess finance charges on the start of the next month. Once those are sent out, and I then receive your check, you are STILL responsible for the finance charge, so please mail your checks early or if you are using an automated system, please have them sent early. Please be sure to check your January bill prior to writing your check. Pavilion Assessment of \$42 per quarter is now OVER - HOO-RAY - (for those of you who were still paying). In addition, the quarterly charge might be different due to change in maintenance fees and/or taxes. So please check the amount on the invoice before automatically writing out your check.

In closing, it's hard to believe that 2010 is coming to a close soon. I thank you all for the opportunity to work here, which I thoroughly enjoy and wish you all a wonderful Holiday Season and a Fabulous, Healthy, and Prosperous 2011!

DID YOU KNOW...


If you want to excavate or in any way change the grading of your leased land, you need to acquire the necessary regulatory approvals and permits from the Town in which you reside (Southeast or North Salem), the New York State Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), as required by those agencies. Copies of those approvals and permits should be filed with the Vail's Grove Cooperative Office prior to any work commencing on leased land to help us answer any questions raised by neighbors.
